Look! It is eating a leaf happily! If you want to see a quokka, you can visit Southwestern Australia.

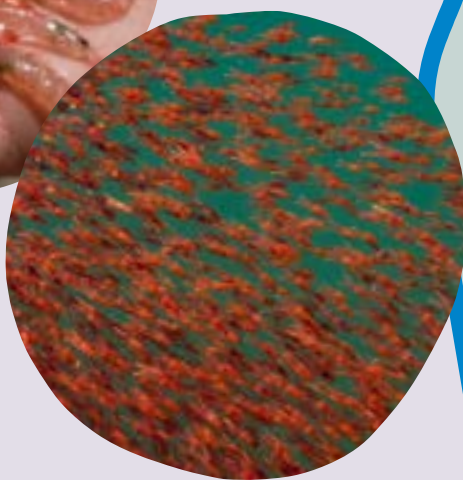
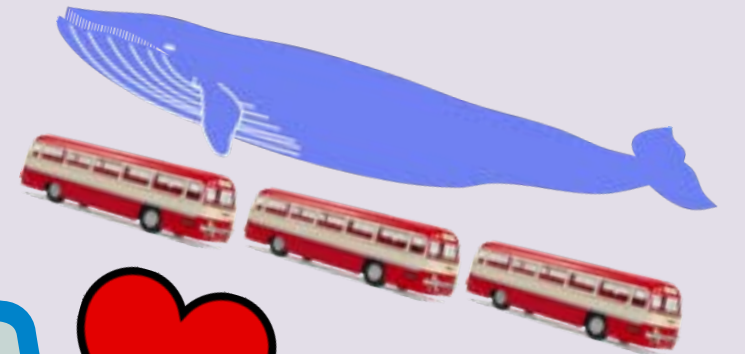
