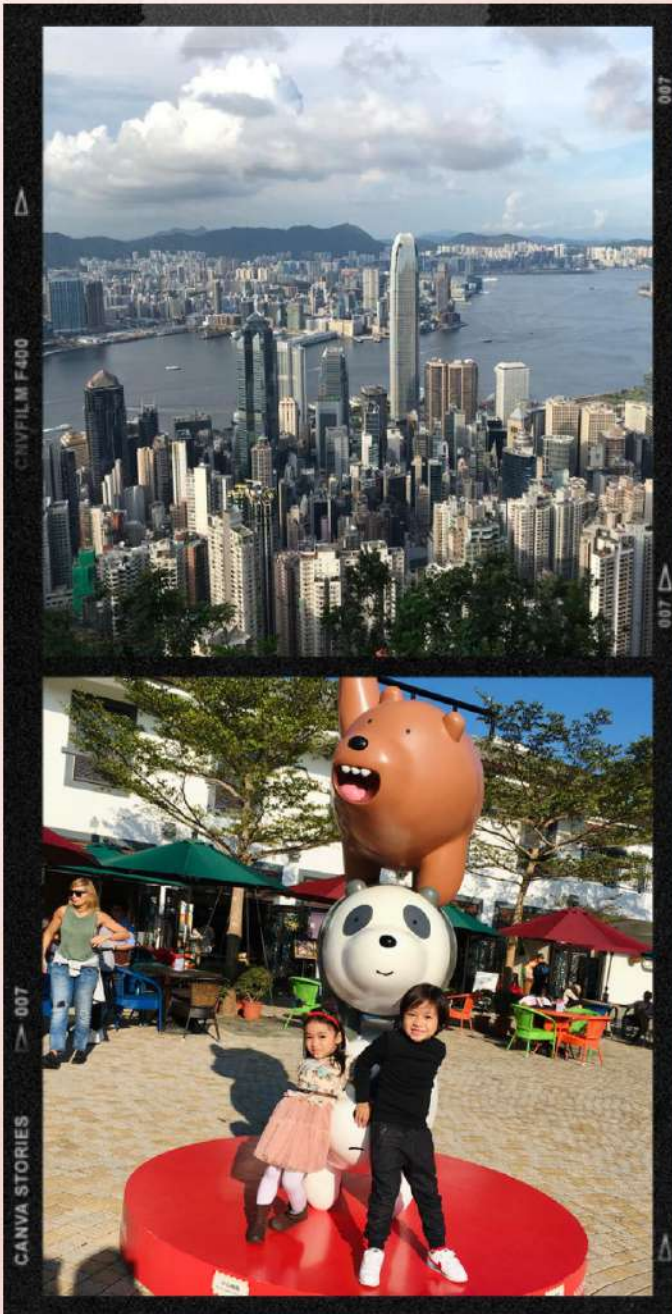


Our Favourite Places in Hong Kong
