Merry Christmas

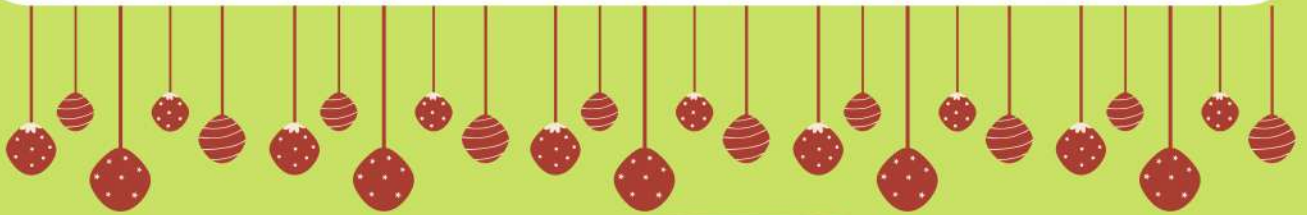
