On New Year's Eve, you can see big fireworks displays. They light up the sky with beautiful colours! Do you like fireworks?



In Hong Kong we also celebrate Lunar New Year.


Do you know it is the **longest holiday** celebration of the year? The celebration lasts for almost **15 days**.

It is a tradition to decorate homes with **red paper** called **Fai Chun**.








An important part of Chinese culture is to give and receive **red packets** called **Lai See**. This lucky money is given to children and young adults by their elders.


